Academics

Notre Dame operates on a semester system that is divided into four 9-week grading periods. Students take eight classes, attending five 60-minute blocks a day, per academic year. Each class meets three hours a week.

Dual Enrollment courses are available through Chattanooga State Community College.

Grading

GPA is computed on a standard unweighted 4.0 scale (A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1) and a weighted 5.0 scale (Honors and Dual Enrollment courses are given an additional 0.5 points and AP courses are given an additional 1.0 point). Notre Dame does not rank students.
